

## Shortbread Baking Contest Rules:

1. Entries must be turned in at the First Presbyterian Church Kirkin' O' The Tartan event by 9:45 am (15 mins before the Kirkin' program commences at 10:00 am).
2. An entry consists of:
  - a. 3 pieces of shortbread in a container (to be taste-tested by the 3 judges)
  - b. a complete recipe OR complete list of ingredients (for allergy and safety purposes)
  - c. a completed and signed registration form (can be completed at the event)
  - d. 2-4 containers (ziploc baggies or something) with 4 pieces each to be sold at the luncheon
3. Items must be entered in the name of the person who made them.
4. Entrants need not be present to win, however, all entry requirements must be accounted for.
5. **ABSOLUTELY NO NUTS** - not that anyone would add nuts to their shortbread recipe; the church is a NUT FREE ZONE.
6. Only one entry per person.
7. Each entry must be made from scratch; you may not enter store-bought cookies.
8. All are welcome to enter, including members of the Scots' Charitable Society and Woman's Auxiliary and members or friends of the First Presbyterian Church.

*All proceeds from the sale of the shortbread will go to the  
Scots' Charitable Society / Woman's Auxiliary Scholarship Fund.*

A single prize of \$25 will be awarded.
